# **OUR TRAINING**

# Transplant Procurement Management Advanced International Training Course

The 28th edition of the Transplant Procurement Management Advanced International Training Course took place in Barcelona from November 6th to November 10th marking the first face-to-face session post the COVID-19 pandemic.

With a total of **66 participants representing 19 countries**, the course provided an international platform for healthcare professionals to share experiences and build networks. The success of the program rested on collaborative efforts within small groups, interactive workshops, and the guidance of an esteemed international faculty specializing in organ and tissue donation and transplantation.

The course aimed to equip participants with the necessary skills to contribute in organ donation and transplantation within their respective countries.





# Curso Superior Internacional en Donación y Trasplante de Órganos y Tejidos

In February, the 33rd edition of the "Curso Superior Internacional en Donación y Trasplante de Órganos y Tejidos" took place in Sant Hilari Sacalm, Barcelona. It was a blended modality learning experience, integrating online sessions with 3 days in-person workshops.

A total of **60 healthcare professionals from 7 different countries** - Andorra, Brazil, Chile, El Salvador, Spain, Mexico, and the Dominican Republic - participated in this learning experience.


# International Master in Donation and Transplantation of Organs, Tissues and Cells

The 19th edition of the International Master in Donation and Transplantation of Organs, Tissues and Cells ended on June 16. A total of **29 students from 17 countries** successfully defended their final dissertations, demonstrating their competence and commitment.

During the 2023 master's program, each student selected three core modules from the following options: Organ Procurement; Leadership, Quality, Management and Innovation; Organ Transplantation; and Tissue Banking and Advanced Therapies.

The master's program now offers students two distinct pathways to tailor their academic journey.


Organized by DTI and the University of Barcelona, this Master's degree awarded all participants a diploma from the university, accrediting them with 60 ECTS credits.



# International Workshop on Family Approach for Organ Donation

The 3rd edition of the International Workshop on Family Approach for Organ Donation took place in December. It helps healthcare professionals with their communication skills to have difficult conversations with patients' families. The aim is to make sure these important talks were led by skilled professionals, boosting agreement rates for organ and tissue donation.

The course had a total of 11 participants from 7 different countries.



# RESEARCH DEVELOPMENT

### **Human Biological Samples Collected in 2023**

We support the establishment of circuits for efficient collection, processing, and shipment of high-quality human biological samples. Our collaborative efforts span across research centers, hospitals, universities, biotech and pharmaceutical companies, technology centers, and biomedical foundations. We monitor donation alerts and collaborate closely with hospitals and biobanks to provide assistance to medical teams, ensuring the procurement of high-quality samples. This year we have help many researches by providing the following tissues:




#### **Technical Validation of Medical Device**

We are delighted to highlight our involvement in the technical validation of an innovative machine in the framework of the LPS project: Ex Situ Perfusion of Porcine Livers for Transplantation Using the Normothermic Liver Perfusion System (NPS-Liver).

Promoted by the Guangdong Shunde Industry Design Institute, under the guidance of Dr. Constantino Fondevila from Hospital Universitario La Paz, and coordinated by DTI Foundation, this initiative aimed to technically validate a liver perfusion device capable of maintaining livers ex situ in normothermia for extended periods. In this second phase of the project, we have validated this technology tranplanting pig livers after 24 hours of perfusion with high survival rates.



# **EUROPEAN PROJECTS**

#### **European Solidarity Corps**

DTI benefited from the involvement of two volunteers hailing from Croatia and Lithuania, who contributed their efforts across various foundation projects, offering invaluable assistance as required. Their volunteer service spanned a duration of nine months.

The primary aim of their engagement centered on bolstering the development and execution of organ and tissue donation training initiatives. Welcoming these volunteers into the Foundation facilitated their comprehensive training in donation and transplantation practices.

The European Solidarity Corps (ESC), formerly known as the European Voluntary Service (EVS) until 2016, represents an international volunteering initiative spearheaded by the European Commission. Geared towards young individuals, the program enables them to embark on solo or group ventures to foreign countries, typically within Europe, to support non-profit endeavors.





### Transforming Universitites Towards Entrepreneurship (TRUE)

The project finalized in June 2023 with a farewell meeting at the University of Barcelona. This project had the mission to remove obstacles that inhibit innovation and entrepreneurship in the university field. It impacted 4,000 European citizens during the funding period and it should impact up to 19,000 by 2030.

DTI designed and developed the "Innovation for teaching training". Throughout four editions, a total of 309 teaching personnel from different faculties have been trained. Participants improved their knowledge on different aspects related to innovation by 38% by the end of the training.



















#### **TEODOR Project**

The TEODOR Project was an initiative aimed at improving organ donation and transplantation education in Latvia, Lithuania and Czech Republic.

The project ended in August 2023. In April there was an event organized at the University of Barcelona, partner of the project, during the last phase of the project. Participants attended this educational sessions guided by "trainers" trained in the project and professors from the University of Barcelona and Karolinska Institute.

Throughout the project the team has participated in online and face-to-face meetings, local seminars, online self-study courses and webinars. Participants in the project counted with guidance, mentorship and feedback from international experts whenever it was demanded.

Overall, the project has shown a 20% knowledge gain from 44 healthcare professionals dedicated to organ donation and a 36% from 30 healthcare professionals dedicated to organ transplantation according to pre and post-tests.






