This **international course** provides comprehensive training for healthcare professionals from around the world. Throughout the course, participants acquire knowledge, share experiences, and become part of an international professional network.

Interaction, teamwork, and practical simulation play a key role in the learning process, helping participants apply the up-to-date theoretical concepts acquired during the training.

ADDRESSED TO:

- **Health professionals involved in organ donation, particularly those working in referral units** such as intensive care, postoperative recovery, and emergency rooms.
- **Donor/transplant coordinators** wishing to update their knowledge and reinforce their skills.
- Healthcare staff to be integrated into a **transplant coordinator's office**.
- **Managers** in charge of organ donation units or transplant programs.

OBJECTIVES

Provide a **comprehensive and detailed overview of the organ donation and transplantation process**, including medical, ethical, legal, and organizational aspects.

Train donor and transplant coordinators in **specific technical and soft skills** such as communication, leadership, and team management.

Promote the **exchange of knowledge experiences** among attendees and enhance the development of **international networks**.

METHODOLOGY



The **TPM Advanced Blended Course** offers a highly practical, immersive and participant-centred learning experience. It follows a **blended modality**:

- 3 online live sessions and 3 face-to-face days in residential format. The course venue is Montanyà Hotel by Senator.
- Lectures dedicated to reviewing concepts and resolving doubts, as well as promoting critical thinking and decision-making.
- Residential experience to create an immersive learning environment. Living and learning in the same setting allows participants to:
 - Maintain continuous dialogue and encourage peer learning.
 - Build strong professional relationships.
 - Extend learning beyond the classroom into informal settings.
- Experiential “learning by doing” in small groups. The course places strong emphasis on experiential learning, where participants actively apply concepts to practice through:
 - Workshops and hands-on activities.
 - Case-based discussions and problem-solving exercises.
 - Small-group work, ensuring interaction, engagement, collaborative learning opportunities and a safe environment for discussion, feedback and reflection.
 - Faculty members act as facilitators and guides, creating the conditions for participants to co-construct knowledge rather than simply receive it.
